EVENT HIGHLIGHTS

12 INTERACTIVE STATIONS

Each station has been created by a local artist, many of whom have lived experience of living in a tent.

Each station is guided by 3 values:

- 1. Humanize an aspect of living unhoused or marginally housed
- 2.Be based in real stories and experiences
- 3. Highlight our need for community and belonging



EXAMPLES OF STATIONS

- A tent is still someone's home
- The harsh realities of weather
- "The longer you are homeless the more homeless you become."
- The ingenuity of survival

LEAD EVENT SPONSOR: \$5,000 (2 needed)

Lead Event Sponsors help cover the costs associated with <u>event</u> <u>infrastructure, event coordination and</u> <u>promotion of the event</u>. This includes temporary fencing, printed materials needed, professional photography and graphic design and event coordinator costs.

STATION SPONSOR: \$1,000 (12 needed)

Additionally, we have prioritized **hiring a care co-cordinator** to ensure that artists have the support they need in telling their stories.
